Successful candidates are awarded a nationally recognised certificate from the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH).

- > Defining Hazard and Risk
- > Identifying Common Hazards
- > Improving Safety Performance
- > Protecting our Environment.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You do not need any formal qualifications to apply for this course. Previous students have been from a range of different industry sectors.

## FUTURE PROSPECTS

On successful completion of the IOSH Working Safely course, progression could be to undertake an IOSH Managing Safely course or NEBOSH certificate.

# NEBOSH Level 3 Certificate in Occupational Health & Safety

## THE DETAILS

The course is suitable for managers, supervisors and staff from all types of organisations who need a broad understanding of health and safety issues and require a recognised health and safety qualification.

The Certificate helps you to manage risks effectively and can be a key part of your development programme. You will gain a sound understanding of the principles of risk management to build an effective safety culture in your company. Smaller organisations, operating in lower risk environments, often choose the NEBOSH National General Certificate as the appropriate qualification for the manager taking the lead on health and safety issues.

The qualification covers the main legal requirements for health and safety in the UK, identification and control of workplace hazards and the practical application of this knowledge. The syllabus is mapped to the National Occupational Standards for Health and Safety.

The duration of study is a minimum of 80 hours plus approximately 50 hours of private study and background reading.

Modules include:

- > Management of Health and Safety
- > Controlling Workplace Hazards
- > Health and Safety Practical Application.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

No previous health and safety knowledge is required but please be aware that the assessment includes a requirement to write a short report.

## FUTURE PROSPECTS

Many people choose this qualification as a first step in a career in health and safety as it provides a solid foundation for further study of the NEBOSH Diploma.



## OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The Management of Health and Safety and Controlling Workplace Hazards modules are taught units which are each assessed by a two-hour written examination. The Health and Safety Practical Application module is assessed by a two-hour practical examination carried out in your workplace.
