Please be aware that requirements can vary between programmes. The key is that you are placed on the correct programme for you.

ARE OTHER QUALIFICATIONS ACCEPTED AS WELL AS GCSES?

Yes, the following are considered too if at an appropriate level:

- Applied GCSEs
- Functional Skills
- IGCSEs
- BTEC certificates or diplomas
- Scottish, Welsh or Northern Ireland Certificates
- OCR national qualifications
- AQA certificates.

WILL I HAVE TO SIT AN ENTRANCE EXAM?

Some study programmes will have some form of initial assessment. It's nothing to worry about and could be in the form of a task or work being sent to the tutor after the interview.
